Do you want to find out about the four seasons? Do you want to find out what animals do in the four seasons? If you do, keep reading these words to find out the answers.



Fall is the season that comes after summer. In the fall, the days get shorter. It gets colder outside, too. Leaves fall off the trees.



In fall, some animals get set for the cold winter by growing thick fur. A few kinds of animals find food and hide it under the soil. The food will not spoil in the ground.





Some kinds of birds join up with other birds.  
Then they all fly south to where it is warmer.



Winter comes after fall. The days get very short in winter and it gets colder, too. In many places, snow falls and water freezes.



Some kinds of animals have to look for food to eat. Others eat the food they hid in the fall.



A few kinds of animals curl up in a warm place in the soil and sleep all winter.



Spring comes after winter. In spring, the days grow longer. It gets warmer outside. Lots of rain falls from the clouds.

In the spring, sleeping animals wake up from their winter snooze. Birds fly up north where it is warm again. Many animals are born.







Summer comes after spring. The sun stays out late, and it gets hot outside. Boys and girls enjoy summer. They don't mind the hot days at all!
